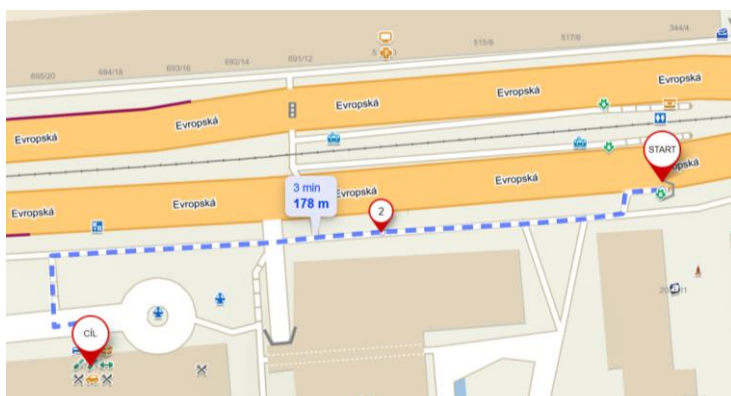


### How to get from the train station to the hotel Diplomat (location of the conference)

**Hotel Diplomat (Evropská 15, 160 41 Praha, Czech republic) is located near the metro station "Dejvická" on route A (green).**

#### How to get to the public transport from train station "Praha hlavní nádraží":

From the platform go down through the underpass once you walk through it you will find yourself in the train station hall. In the second part of the big train station hall are located the exits from the train station and the entrances to the metro station. Take the metro with the direction (green route A), get off at the next stop "Muzeum". Here you will take the red route C, direction "Nemocnice Motol". Get off at the stop "Dejvická", from there get to the street "Evropská" through the exit E4. Once you walk through the exit take the path as shown in the map.



#### Where can you buy tickets:

Ticket terminals are installed in every tram, city bus or in any metro lobby. They are meant for the sale of single and short-term tickets. There is no option to pay with a card in the metro carriages yet. Ticket terminals are installed in every metro station and in some stops of the surface transport (at some of them there remains the only option of purchase by coins).

The tickets can also be purchased at the information centre of "Dopravní podnik hl. m. Prahy".

Another purchasing option is the mobile app "Lítačka", which can also help you find the right transport connection.

### **Night time service of City public transport**

From **0:30 to 4:30** the daily metro connections, trams and busses (number 91–99) arrive in a single interval every 30 minutes (except on Friday and Saturday nights. At these times the interval is 20 minutes). All night tram lines converge at the central stop "**Lazarská**" some of them also stop at other designated locations. Then the city bus links (number 901–915), arrive every 30 minutes (except on Friday and Saturday nights. At these times the interval is 20 minutes) or 60 minutes at the chosen transfer points or on a different bus link.

### **Emergency calls**

Calling this phone number is free and it's available non-stop.

112 Singular phone number used for emergency calls in Europe. This phone number is meant to be used to notify the authorities of any major event. The operators know Czech, English, German and other languages.

### **Luggage storage**

Whether you arrive to Prague by the train, bus or by plane, you have the option to safely store your luggage. At the airport the storage is located in the right rear corner of the departure hall "**Terminal 2**" in the city centre you can use the storage at the main train station "**Praha hlavní nádraží**", train station "**Masarykovo nádraží**" or at the bus station "**Florenc**".
