



## **Portugal: Effects and Impact of ECI** in the Lisbon metropolitan area



Over the last eleven years, Local ECI Teams based their actions on an approach not based on special needs, but on the special rights of children and their respective families.

  - While promoting emerging skills and making the family and other significant caregivers co-responsible, through strengthening their skills, so that they become a proactive element in the entire Intervention process.


