# Transportation from Prague Airport



The connection between Václav Havel Airport Prague and Prague city centre is provided by public transport bus lines which operate at regular few-minute intervals. Bus stops are located directly in front of terminals.

## Here are the steps to get from the airport to the hotel using public transportation:

Buy your ticket before boarding the bus. Ticket machines are in the arrival hall of Terminal 1 and Terminal 2 or directly at public transport stops. You can also purchase tickets at a kiosk near the bus stop, or from the bus driver (although this option is slightly more expensive). Make sure to validate your ticket once you're on the bus by stamping it in the machine.



### What Ticket should I use?

All of the following tickets are valid on all PID lines in Prague, which include: metro, trams, buses (apart from the line AE), ferries and integrated passenger trains (S lines).

All tickets are fully transferable, validity is limited only by time. **Please do not forget to validate your ticket.**

### Ticket prices in Prague (simplified)

**Free travel:** Children under 6 years and adults from 70 years of age travel for free.

(\*) **Discounted “half-price”** tickets can be used by persons from 60 to 65 years.

## How to get to the hotel Vienna House Diplomat with public transport.



Exit the airport terminal (Terminal1 ist international, Terminal2 is for Schengen) and follow the signs to the bus stop for bus number 119. You can find the bus stop outside Terminal 1 and Terminal 2 too. The bus stop for the 119 is clearly marked and easy to find.



Take the 119 bus heading towards Nádraží Veleslavín. This bus runs frequently, usually every 10-20 minutes, and the journey to Nádraží Veleslavín takes around 15-20 minutes.

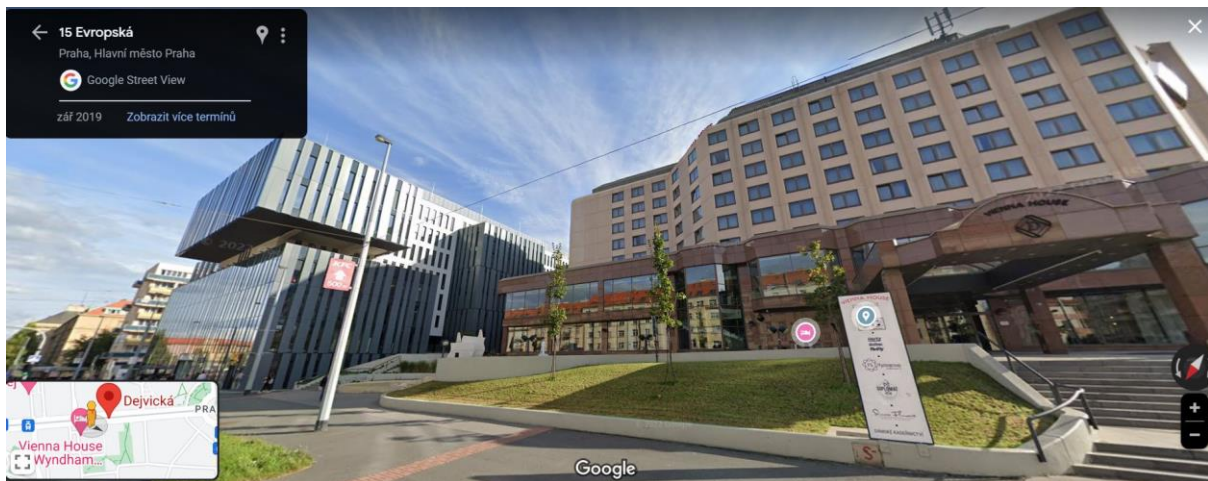
Once you arrive at Nádraží Veleslavín, you have two options to reach Vienna House Diplomat Hotel:

**Option 1:** Take the metro **A line** from Nádraží Veleslavín to Dejvická station. The metro runs frequently, usually every 3-5 minutes, and the journey takes around 4 minutes. Exit the metro station **DEJVICKÁ** and use the escalator exit. (There are only stairs on the other side.) The Vienna House Diplomat hotel is on the left side, a few steps straight ahead.

**Option 2:** Take the tram number 26 from the tram stop at Nádraží Veleslavín direction Nádraží Hostivař. The tram runs frequently, usually every 5-10 minutes, and the journey to the hotel takes around 10-15 minutes. Get off the tram at the **Dejvická** stop. The tram stop is almost exactly in front of the hotel. The hotel is on the right side, just cross the street and go few steps back.

## Taxi, Cab



Here are 3 companies that offer taxi services for transportation from Prague Airport to the city center:

**AAA Radiotaxi** - To book a ride, you can call +420 222 333 222 or use their online booking system on their website at [www.aaataxi.cz/en/home/](http://www.aaataxi.cz/en/home/). The average fare from Prague Airport to the city center is around 600 CZK (approximately 28 USD).



**Profi Taxi** - You can book a ride by calling +420 261 314 151 or by using their mobile app, which is available on both Android and iOS. The average fare from Prague Airport to the city center is around 500 CZK (approximately 23 USD).

**Hallo Taxi** - To book a ride, you can call +420 244 114 411 or use their online booking system on their website at [www.hallotaxi.cz](http://www.hallotaxi.cz). The average fare from Prague Airport to the city center is around 600CZK (approximately 28 USD).
